

# NOTICE OF TAX REVENUE INCREASE

The County of Lamar conducted public hearings on August 20, 2019 and September 3, 2019 on a proposal to increase the total tax revenues of the County of Lamar from properties on the tax roll in the preceding year by 4.6 percent.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised last year at last year's rate of .3940 for each \$100 of taxable value was \$13,395,400.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of .3940 for each \$100 of taxable value, excluding tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$13,967,840.

The total tax revenue proposed to be raised this year at the proposed tax rate of .3940 for each \$100 of taxable value, including tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year, is \$14,117,076.

The Lamar County Commissioners' Court is scheduled to vote on the tax rate that will result in that tax increase at a public meeting to be held on September 16, 2019 at the Lamar County Courthouse, County Courtroom, 119 N. Main St. Paris, TX at 5:30 p.m.

The Lamar County Commissioners' Court proposes to use the increase in total tax revenue for the purpose of paying for unfunded mandates and capital improvement projects.
