DECLARING A STATE OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the County of Lamar on February 20, 2018 and continuing through February 28, 2018, has suffered severe damage to County Roads and Bridges, resulting from torrential rainfall measuring from 8 to 12 inches, resulting in:


- Many County Roads remain impassable
- The closure of eighteen County Roads
- Bridges on County Roads have been damaged
- Culverts on County Roads have been washed out
- Debris on County roads from limbs and uprooted trees
- Rock on County Roads have been washed away and must be replaced before the roads can be re-opened

WHEREAS, AS County Judge of Lamar County, I have determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to rehabilitate and restore the County roads by replacing culverts, bridges and the rock that the excessive rainfall washed away.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF LAMAR COUNTY:

1. That a State of Disaster is declared for the unincorporated areas of the Lamar County.
2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this State of Disaster which occurred on February 20th through February 28th will continue until the damage from the torrential rainfall is restored.
4. That this proclamation shall take effect from and after its issuance.
