5. **BRIEF NARRATIVE:** On 08/05/2018 at about 1836, I was dispatched to 2198 CR 22500 in response to a report of estray livestock. Dispatch advised that a horse, which possibly belonged to a Bill Woods, was in Jimmy Newsom's hay meadow. Dispatch tried to call Woods at his listed phone number and there was no answer. Upon arrival, I met with Jimmy Newsom. I observed a sorrel horse in the meadow on the north side of the road. Newsom told me that the horse probably belonged to Bill Woods and that Woods possibly lived in Oklahoma. Dispatch advised that they had still not heard from Mr. Woods. I summoned Johnny Newman to the scene to catch and impound the horse as I was unable to reach Mr. Woods to come get his animal and I was unable to catch it myself. Newman caught the horse and transported it to Cattlemen's Livestock Commission, 1354 Clement Rd. The horse was a mature sorrel gelding with a white star on his forehead and white socks on both rear feet.
